5. I do not see how moving the entrance to the school from a quiet B road with little HGV traffic (because of the low bridge at Dorridge) to a busy A road can in any way improve Student safety – especially a road where the current development plans show it being used for access for some 1000 extra cars, immediately adjoining the school entrance.

Further it will not remove congestion from Station Road because the only convenient parking for pupil drop off/collection will remain in Knowle centre and surrounding streets.

The statement that funding will be via section 106 agreements seems wrong. Of the Council's projected development costs for the new school of £58 million only £6 million comes from 106 agreements. Even using the most optimistic income and building cost figures as supplied by the Council there is a funding shortfall of £14 million. As the shortfall is partly to be covered by "value engineering to school design" it is reasonable to assume that the first features sacrificed will be "facilities to be used and enjoyed by the wider community".

The scheme also requires the compulsory purchase of some 13 acres of land previously put forward for residential development.

6. Surely rather than demolish buildings where the Council has spent many millions of Pounds in recent years, the available funds would be far better spent on a thorough modernisation of the existing school with all necessary additions. This would put the scheme on a sound commercial footing and serve the best interests of pupils, parents, staff, taxpayers and the community as a whole.
