Are Arden school /academy competent to manage a project like this when they sought millions for buildings that are to be demolished? (There must be some schools that would have made better use of these limited educational funds). If we are sacrificing never to be replaced green belt land then we should take care that the resources remain under as much democratic control as possible. It is a massive deal to change the shape of an area so much and considerations of long term accountability are important. Will the school and its sixth form be obliged to serve the walking distance and near community or will it want to select its pupils in 10/20/30 years' time in pursuit of "excellence" from further afield. Will the public have any right to use these facilities or is this just going to be up to the school's goodwill or the highest bidders? If the school buildings are part of a PFI deal the profit element for the provider may well exceed the environmental savings on ongoing running costs. Will the new primary school be under local authority control and be neither part of an academy or a faith group.
