We note that reference is made to requirement for a “net gain” in biodiversity of at least 10% compared with the pre-development baseline. It is not clear whether the Council intend to bring a 10% requirement ahead of the Environment Bill being passed, this is potentially before the Plan’s scheduled adoption in 2022. We do not consider that the Council is justified in bringing this requirement forward ahead of the Bill being approved, unless it can demonstrate evidence of this requirement being evidence based.

We support reference to Natural England standing advice in relation to ancient woodland and veteran trees. This is the most appropriate guidance to take note of in respect of these trees.

16 i makes reference to development proposals being required to demonstrate that they have considered impact on tranquility. We request that the Council clarify what is meant the reference to tranquility, and how the impact on tranquility will be measured. We are unsure how this will be assessed as part of a planning application. Without this evidence we do not consider the policy as written to be justified or effective.
