1 ix makes reference to development proposals being required to demonstrate that they have considered impact on tranquility. We request that the Council clarify what is meant by this, we are unsure how this will be assessed as part of a planning application.

We note that paragraph 123 of the NPPF references that planning policies and decisions should aim to "identify and protect" areas of tranquility. It is however not clear where the Council considers these areas to be with the Borough, and requirements for consideration of tranquility within a planning application. We request this clarification to ensure that the policy requirement is effective and justified.
