We **object** to the requirement at 2 vii for all new development to deliver new and improved health services. This is not justified and therefore not effective due to requirement being placed on all development sites without site specific consideration. Delivering new and improved health facilities as part of all new developments. New health facilities should not be a blanket requirement no all new developments and should be considered on a site by site basis. Where improvements are needed in health services or facilities, but a new building or facility is not required, then financial contributions could be sought to improve existing facilities. Therefore we recommend that the policy is amended to allow for financial contributions where improvements are identified as the necessary mitigation to make development acceptable in planning terms.

Nevertheless, Hampton Road Developments supports the principle of this policy. Health is an important consideration. The proposals at Hampton Road, will achieve this through the provision of accessible public open space and improved sports provision which will allow current and future residents to access opportunities to exercise – leading to a benefit to physical and mental wellbeing
