The proposed relocation of the Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) to a site within the UK2 allocation is legally non-compliant as I believe this is the first time that the proposal has been published (in previous documents/issues of the plan) and therefore does not comply with Solihull's Statement of Community Involvement. Furthermore, I could find no evidence regarding this proposal on how the Local Planning Authority (LPA) complied with the duty to "engage constructively, actively and on an ongoing basis with neighbouring authorities" i.e. the LPA has failed to comply with the duty to co-operate.						
I believe the Tests of Soundness have not been met by the LPA with regards to this proposal because no evidence appears to have been provided to justify the six bullet points set out in paragraph 354 that all options/sites have been fully explored to identify the preferred location. Furthermore, the 3rd bullet point states the site"accords with the policy on the location of waste management facilities" yet no policy is referenced. The 5th and 6th bullet points state "with sufficient space for queuing vehicles at peak times" and "the site is relatively isolated from residential use" yet no access/egress points or the location of the HWRC have been identified/shown within UK2 allocation. Given the proposal is to expand the HWRC within the UK2 allocation, there does not appear to be evidence of any traffic/environmental assessments eg. traffic accessing the site and impact of traffic on the residential roads in the area that will be used to reach the site. END
